Dear Medical Aid Abroad

We have just returned from our latest surgical camp at Kagando Hospital, Uganda. This was my third visit. Thanks to your generosity, the camp was a resounding success. We screened 122 women, performed 96 prolapse and fistula operations, and treated several others with medications and pessaries.

In total we spent approximately NZ\$43,000 on patient surgeries, transport costs and food. (Our transport, accomodation and food was self funded) We were also able to provide some training for a local surgeon who attended the camp. As always, the patients were extremely grateful for your support and the donated instruments and supplies from Medical Aid Abroad.

We are now planning to return to Kagando in February next year, and also do a prolapse camp in nearby Kasese with Dr Abraham - the local doctor who has just finished his Gynaecology training - again thanks to your support.
